CABINET MEMORANDUM

(Circulated under Rule 17 of the Assam rules of Executive Business' 1968.)

Sub : Creation of new Revenue Circles.

1. The Revenue & D.M. Department has been receiving demands for creation of new Revenue Circles. The Committee having Addl. Chief Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Revenue & D.M. Department as its Chairman and the concerned DCs as Member examined the proposals and recommended creation of the new Revenue Circles as mentioned below:

2. In view of the fact that Revenue Circles being the core of District Administration and involving people at the grassroot level, it has become necessary to re-organize/create new Revenue Circles. Apart from normal revenue works, Circle Officers now a days have to involve themselves in various works of other Department and misc. works resulting in multifold workload and therefore, to enable revenue circle offices to function effectively, it has become necessary to reduce the area and population covered by each revenue circle.

The proposed revenue circles at times do not fulfil the existing norms, but due to backwardness of some areas, lack of communication and as the member of public in general prefer to go to circle offices rather than the district headquarters to sort out their problems, it may be necessary to create new revenue circles on these grounds.

3. The creation of new revenue circles would ease out problems and bring people at the grass root level closer to administration. The Committee examined and recommended the following norms relaxing the earlier norms for creation of Circle subject to approval of

4. 1) Rangapara Revenue Circle, Sonitpur.

DC, Sonitpur has proposed creation of Rangapara Revenue Circle to be bifurcated from Chariduar Revenue Circle consisting of Bahbari, Chariduar, Goroimari & Balipara Mouzas having HQ at Rangapara.

Rangapara Town being one of the oldest and important town of Sonitpur District is also a railway junction. The entire Rangapara town and its peripheries fall under the administration of Balipara Mouza.

So, creation of the new Circle will ease the difficulties which are presently faced by the people of Bahbari Mouza. Moreover, Rangapara town is located at the centre of all the above three Mouzas and there are facilities of almost all the leading banks in addition to the other essential services. The only Police Station i.e. the Rangapara P.S. under the jurisdiction of the Chariduar Revenue Circle is located in Rangapara town itself.

From the administration point of view, creation of the proposed Circle will certainly ease difficulties of the people of the three Mouzas.

4. 2) Bargang Revenue Circle, Sonitpur.

DC, Sonitpur has proposed creation of a new Revenue Circle at Bargang to be carved out of Biswanath Revenue Circle which is comparatively a big Revenue Circle. Creation of a new Circle at Bargang will not only lead to the administrative convenience and efficient Revenue Administration but it will also help in dealing with the Law and Order situation followed by prompt administrative control throughout the remote areas under the proposed Circle.

It is administratively desirable also because the areas on Assam-Arunachal Border will fall in this Circle and also various tribal communities inhabit in these areas. District administrative will find it easier to have effective vigil on law & order situation.
